- It is a scheme that lets young people in Scotland with care
 experience apply for money to fund creative projects in
 writing or other creative projects. Grants are usually up to

- You can apply for funding to develop an existing creative project, or to support a new hobby you haven't tried before!

What can I apply to the fund for?

- You can apply for money for any support you feel you need for a creative project
- Some examples of what you might like to apply for funding for include (but are not limited to):
 - Access to mentors with professional experience in writing or other artforms
 - · Equipment or musical instruments
 - Transport to get to workshops or lessons
 - Recording or publishing costs
 - Group grants for collaborative projects
 - Opportunities to showcase your work
